



IMPERIAL CHINA TRIANGLE

Beijing | Xian | Shanghai – 10 DAYS/9 NIGHTS

First we take you to Beijing, walk along the Great Wall, and stand in the Tiananmen Square, explore the splendours of the Forbidden City and wander through the grounds of the Summer Palace. Then on to Xian, the ancient Tang capital. Here you will see the Terracotta Warriors archaeological site, the Small Goose Pagoda and other features of the country's fabulous past; round off the trip in the fabulous Shanghai. All this together with spectacular evening entertainments and unique local cuisines will make this a tour to remember.

DAY 1 – Arrive Beijing: Arrival private transfer to hotel. [Fairmont Beijing]

DAY 2 – Beijing: After breakfast you will visit Tiananmen Square, look across the vast space to the Great Hall of the People and stand before the massive Tianamen (Heavenly Peace) Gate. Lying behind is the Forbidden City, as the former imperial palace is called, where the magnificent marble courtyards, huge halls, gilded temples and ornate pavilions the residence of the emperors and their families are now open to your wonderment. DAY 3 – BEIJING: You will be taken north today to pace the ramparts of China's famed Great Wall. This evening a traditional Peking Duck dinner completes a very special day. [Fairmont Beijing / Meals: B L D]

DAY 4 – Beijing: Today you will visit the Summer Palace. Languid willows and painted pavilions surround the scenic Kunming Lake. Finally you will visit the Temple of Heaven, the beautiful blue-tiled buildings here represent the epitome of Ming architecture. [Fairmont Beijing / Meals: B L]

DAY 5 – Beijing to Xian: You transfer to the airport for your flight to Xian, the capital city of the Tang Dynasty over 1,000 years ago. You will visit the Shaanxi Museum, acclaimed as

“the Gallery of Chinese Culture”. Then visit the wonderful Big Wild Goose Pagoda, the symbol of Xian. [Xian Hilton / Meals: B L]

DAY 6 – Xian: This morning you visit the remarkable archaeological site where the Terracotta Warriors were discovered and followed by the walk along the top of the Xian City Wall which encircles the inner city. This evening enjoy the lavish spectacle of the Tang Dynasty Show, one of the highlights of the tour. [Xian Hilton / Meals: B L D]

DAY 7 – Xian to Shanghai: Fly to Shanghai and transfer to your luxury hotel on arrival. Dominating the Yangtze Delta, Shanghai is the pulsating commercial heart of China. Walk along the famous Bund look across to the fantastic skyscrapers of the Pudong district. After lunch you will visit the beautifully maintained Yu Garden, an outstanding example of a classical garden and explore the bustling market area. This evening you will be entertained by one of Shanghai's famous acrobatic troupes. [Fairmont Peace Hotel Shanghai / Meals: B L]

DAY 8 – Shanghai: This morning you will ascend the Shanghai World Financial Centre Observatory for an astonishing view over the city. Next comes a visit to the renowned Shanghai Museum which is famous for its collection
