Siem Reap | Angkor Wat | Saigon | Mekong Delta | Hanoi | Halong Bay | Luang Prabang – 13 DAYS/12 NIGHTS

The Indochinese countries of Vietnam, Cambodia & Laos are captivatingly diverse. In bustling Vietnam you will feel the pulse of Saigon, be intrigued by Halong Bay and soak up the atmosphere of gracious Hanoi. In neighbouring Laos, discover one of Asia's most enchanting cities in fabled Luang Prabang, a treasure trove of temples and colonial-era architecture. Finish your journey in Siem Reap where you will witness dawn over Angkor Wat, and explore remote, jungle enveloped temples.

DAY 1 – Arrive Siem Reap: Arrive in Siem Reap, home of the cradle of Khmer civilisation and majestic Angkor Wat. [Raffles Grand Hotel D'Angkor / Meals: D]

DAY 2 – Siem Reap Temples of Angkor: Depart early for sunrise at Angkor Wat. After breakfast take a tethered balloon ride and then drive through Angkor Thom city and past Bayon to Ta Phrom. This afternoon visit Tonle Sap. [Raffles Grand Hotel D'Angkor / Meals: B L]

DAY 3 – Siem Reap Outerlying Temples: Today you will visit the outerlying temple of Boeng Melea, stopping at Dom Deak local Market along the way, visit Banteay Srei, Akira Landmine Museum and Banteay Samre before returning to town. [Raffles Grand Hotel D'Angkor / Meals: B]

DAY 4 – Siem Reap to Saigon: Fly to Saigon today, the bustling commercial capital of Vietnam. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure. [Saigon Sofitel Plaza / Meals: B L]

DAY 5 – Saigon: See the sights of old and new Saigon in the central 'French quarter', then visit Cu Chi Tunnels. [Saigon Sofitel Plaza / Meals: B L]

DAY 6 – Mekong Delta: Explore the Mekong Delta's canals, orchards and towns by boat and interact with the friendly locals. [Saigon Sofitel Plaza / Meals: B L]

DAY 7 – Saigon to Hanoi: Fly to Hanoi and visit historic Ba Dinh Square, the Ho Chi Minh Quarter, the infamous Hoa Lo (Hanoi Hilton) prison and the peaceful Temple of Literature. [Sofitel Legend Metropole Hanoi / Meals: B L]

DAY 8 – Hanoi to Halong Bay: Spend a magical night on board your private boat in Halong Bay. [Bhaya Cruise / Meals: B L D]

DAY 9 – Halong Bay to Hanoi: Disembark this afternoon and drive back to Hanoi. [Sofitel Legend Metropole Hanoi / Meals: B L]

DAY 10 – Halong Bay to Luang Prabang: Fly to Luang Prabang this morning. Spend the afternoon walking around the city's many beautiful temples. Luang Prabang is perhaps the best preserved traditional city in South East Asia. The tranquility and charm of this city with its splendid natural scenery and cultural sights make it one of the most delightful places to visit in Laos. [Luangsay Residence / Meals: B L]

DAY 11 – Luang Prabang: Travel up the Mekong River by slow boat to visit Pak Ou (thousand Buddha) caves. [Luangsay Residence / Meals: B L]

DAY 12 – Luang Prabang: Rise early this morning to witness hundreds of robed monks in the morning alms tradition. Visit a local market
