Hanoi | Halong Bay | Hue | Hoi An | Saigon | Mekong Delta – 11 DAYS/10 NIGHTS

Vietnam's capital of Hanoi is a brilliant place to begin your journey of exploration, the city is quintessentially Asian and yet reminiscent of Paris in its broad tree lined boulevards. You wouldn't want to miss Halong Bay with its Pagodas; palaces and the surreal limestone karst. Move onto the ancient capital of Hue, the home of emperors, and the exquisite trading town Hoi An. Finally far to the South, experience the energy of Saigon.

**DAY 1 – Arrive Hanoi:** Upon arrival in Hanoi you will be met and transferred to your hotel. [Sofitel Legend Metropole Hanoi]

**DAY 2 – Hanoi:** Explore Hanoi with a walking tour through the Old Quarter, a visit to historic Ba Dinh Square and the Ho Chi Minh Quarter, the infamous Hoa Lo (Hanoi Hilton) prison and the peaceful Temple of Literature, before an evening theatrical water puppet performance. **DAY 3 – Hanoi to Halong Bay:** Journey east and spend a magical night onboard your private boat on Halong Bay. [Bhaya Cruise / Meals: B L D]

**DAY 4 – Halong Bay to Hanoi:** Disembark and drive back to Hanoi. This afternoon explore the backstreets of Hanoi on a food orientated walking tour. [Sofitel Legend Metropole Hanoi / Meals: B]

**DAY 5 – Hanoi to Hue:** Fly to the ancient capital, Hue, and dissected by the delightfully named Perfume River; Wander through the streets and see why the Citadel and Forbidden Purple City are World Heritage listed by UNESCO. Travel along the river to Emperor Tu Duc's tomb, enjoy an introduction to Vietnamese calligraphy and hold a discourse with a local monk about Buddhism. [La Residence Hotel & Spa / Meals: B L]

**DAY 6 – Hue to Hoi An:** This morning drive to Hoi An via the spectacular Hai Van pass. Set on the Thu Bon River, this beautiful port city reveals its 17th century French, Portuguese and Japanese influences during a morning walking tour. The cooking class at the famous Red Bridge Cooking School reveals some secrets of Vietnamese cuisine. [Anantara Hoi An Resort / Meals: B L]

**DAY 7 – Hoi An:** Free day to explore this quaint town with its many galleries, handicraft shops, tailors and cafes – or relaxing at your hotel. [Anantara Hoi An Resort / Meals: B L]

**DAY 8 – Hoi An to Saigon:** Free time in Hoi An before flying to the vibrant and bustling city of Saigon. [Saigon Sofitel / Meals: B L]

**DAY 9 – Saigon:** Visit the Cu Chi Tunnels and see the sights of old and new Saigon in the central 'French quarter'. Visit the Reunification Palace and War Remnants Museum. [Saigon Sofitel / Meals: B L]

**DAY 10 – Mekong Delta:** Explore the Mekong Delta's canals, markets and villages by speed boat. [Saigon Sofitel / Meals: B L]

**DAY 11 – Depart Saigon:** Today you will be transferred to the airport for your onward journey. [Meals: B]
