



TEMPLES OF ANGKOR

Phnom Penh | Siem Reap – 5 DAYS/4 NIGHTS

Picture yourself gazing at a spectacular sunrise over Angkor Wat. The ‘Temples of Angkor’ represent the determination and irrepensible spirit of a thousand years past. The artistry, precision and scale will inspire you. Phnom Penh, Cambodia’s colourful capital, is a riverside city of French-colonial architecture, Khmer art galleries and quiet cafés. You will get a taste of both modern and ancient Asia on this journey through the country’s highlights.



DAY 1 – Arrive Phnom Penh: Upon arrival in Phnom Penh you will be met and transferred to your hotel. [Raffles Le Royal / Meals: B L]

DAY 2 – Phnom Penh: Explore the Central Market, Royal Palace, Silver Pagoda and National Museum. Later learn about the Khmer Rouge at Toul Sleng. [Raffles Le Royal / Meals: B L D]

DAY 3 – Phnom Penh to Siem Reap: Fly to Siem Reap, gateway to Angkor and take a boat ride on Tonle Sap Lake, the excursion to the fascinating floating villages, where you will see family life on the water, fishermen cleaning their nets, children at play, and even a floating church and school. [Raffles Grand Hotel / Meals: B L D]

DAY 4 – Siem Reap: Explore the awe-inspiring Angkor Wat Temple, the largest religious monument ever built which is spectacular. Its five towers are recognized around the world. This afternoon you explore the vast archaeological treasure and wonder, the temple complex of Angkor. The South Gate of the royal city of Angkor Thom is your first stop. The Bayon is a pyramid type temple with huge carved faces throughout. Also visit the Grand Elephant Terrace, and Terrace of the Leper King. [Raffles Grand Hotel / Meals: B L]

DAY 5 – Depart Siem Reap: Today you will be transferred to the airport for your onward journey. [Meals: B]
