



VIETNAM & TEMPLE OF ANGKOR

Hanoi | Halong Bay | Hoi An | Saigon | Mekong Delta | Siem Reap – 12 DAYS/11 NIGHTS

Vietnam's capital of Hanoi is a brilliant place to begin your journey of exploration. You wouldn't want to miss Halong Bay, then ancient trading town Hoi An, and vibrant Saigon and Siem Reap, home to the awe inspiring Angkor Temples, is a great way to round off a trip in two of Asia's most exciting countries. DAY 1 – Hanoi: Upon arrival in Hanoi you will be met and transferred to your hotel. [Sofitel Legend Metropole Hanoi]

DAY 2 – Hanoi: Explore Hanoi with a walking tour through the Old Quarter, a visit to historic Ba Dinh Square and the Ho Chi Minh Quarter, the infamous Hoa Lo (Hanoi Hilton) prison and the peaceful Temple of Literature, before an evening theatrical water puppet performance. DAY 3 – Hanoi to Halong Bay: Depart Hanoi for the famous Halong Bay and spend a magical night on board your private boat on Halong Bay. [Bhaya Cruise / Meals: B L D]

DAY 4 – Halong Bay to Hanoi: This morning discover Halong Bays most untouched beaches, tunnels and caves. Return to Hanoi. Explore the backstreets of Hanoi on a food orientated walking tour. [Sofitel Legend Metropole Hanoi / Meals: B L]

DAY 5 – Hanoi to Hoi An: This morning fly to Danang and transfer to Hoi An. Set on the Thu Bon River, this beautiful port city reveals its 17th century French, Portuguese and Japanese influences during a morning walking tour. The cooking class at the famous Red Bridge Cooking School reveals some secrets of Vietnamese cuisine. [Anantara Hoi An Resort / Meals: B L]

DAY 6 – Hoi An: Free day to explore this quaint town with its many galleries, handicraft shops, tailors and cafes – or relaxing at your hotel. [Anantara Hoi An Resort / Meals: B L]

DAY 7 – Hoi An to Saigon: Free time in Hoi An before flying to the vibrant and bustling city of Saigon. [Saigon Sofitel/Meals: B L]

DAY 8 – Saigon: Visit the Cu Chi Tunnels and see the sights of old and new Saigon in the central 'French quarter'. Visit the Reunification Palace and War Remnants Museum. [Saigon Sofitel / Meals: B L]

DAY 9 – Mekong Delta: Explore the Mekong Delta's canals, markets and villages by speed boat. [Saigon Sofitel / Meals: B L]

DAY 10 – Saigon to Siem Reap: Fly to Siem Reap, gateway to Angkor and take a boat ride on Tonle Sap Lake. [Raffles Grand Hotel / Meals: B L]

DAY 11 – Siem Reap: Explore Angkor Wat then board a regular vehicle for the outer-lying temples of Banteay Srei, Ta Prohm and more. [Raffles Grand Hotel / Meals: B L]

DAY 12 – Depart Siem Reap: Today you will be transferred to the airport for your onward journey. [Meals: B]
